Take notice that on December 16, 2016, NorthStar Group Holdings, LLC, LVI Parent Corp., NorthStar Group Services, Inc., NorthStar Decommissioning Holdings, LLC, NorthStar Nuclear Decommissioning Company, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Vermont Investment Company, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC, and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., filed a Joint Petition with the Vermont Public Service Board, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 107, 231, and 232, seeking an order issuing such approvals as are necessary to authorize NorthStar Decommissioning Holdings, LLC, and its affiliates as necessary, to acquire directly or indirectly a controlling interest in Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC, which owns the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station in Vernon (“Vermont Yankee”) and following such acquisition will be renamed “NorthStar VY,” and to substitute NorthStar Nuclear


Decommissioning Company, LLC, for Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., as the operator of Vermont Yankee, under the Certificate of Public Good issued in Dockets 6545 and 7862, for purposes of earlier decommissioning and site restoration; to approve site restoration standards for Vermont Yankee; and to approve issuance by NorthStar VY of a note in the amount of up to \$145 million to reimburse costs incurred to manage spent nuclear fuel at Vermont Yankee.
